## History of TYPO3

TYPO3 was developed from scratch by Kasper Skårhøj, a Danish developer, in 1997. The term "Content Management" was still widely unknown, but as websites became increasingly complex, it became clear that a system that separated design and content was a smart solution to an emerging problem. Today, TYPO3 is one of the best and most secure open source CMS available at the enterprise level and we are working hard to keep it that way.

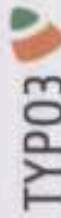
